

# *ABOUT CROSSROADS RACING SERIES*

Crossroads was formed as a vision of wanting to bring multiple disciplines of motorcycle racing together and create something a little different, while providing a safe, fun, and fair experience for all racers and spectators.

We want to bring the “Fun” factor back into off road racing and provide a family oriented series for all to enjoy. We feel Off Road racing needs to come together as one family with the same goals and expectations.

We have spoken to literally 100's of people (racer's, spectators, vendors, and sponsor's) and believe we have come up with a formula that will allow us to provide something for everybody.

With a hybrid course design (Cross Country, GP, MX, Enduro-X) racers will have a chance to hone their skills across the board and truly be a better rider and have fun while they ride. The hybrid track will offer spectators much more opportunity to see the racing action multiple areas of the lap without having to cover a lot of ground. The course will be shorter, allowing for more laps and closer racing. The shorter track distance also allows for easier course clearing during the race assisting in staying on-time.

All Crossroads races will be a two day format. All youth and pee wee classes (bikes & quads) will run on Saturday starting at 10:00 am (local time). We will provide family fun activities every Saturday evening after the conclusion of all races. Sunday will consist of all Adult classes, broken up into an A.M. & P.M. schedule. The A.M. classes will essentially run the older youth course. This allows us time to adjust the course if needed prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> race Sunday morning. This helps keep all races on schedule. The P.M. classes will have another loop added to the A.M. course. We believe this format will provide a safer experience for all racers and help keep all races on schedule.
